It is a view of a grove of giant bamboo that is growing in the middle of the rhododendron garden near Chilco Street. The paper is embossed by cutting the linoleum deeply, then printing with a thick wool etching felt that pushes the paper into the cuts. Before the paper is pulled off the inked block I use my fingertip to further push the five main bamboo stalks into the cuts.
